

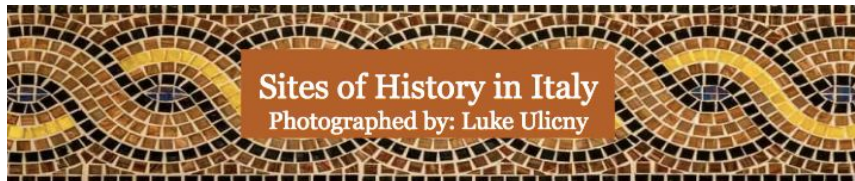

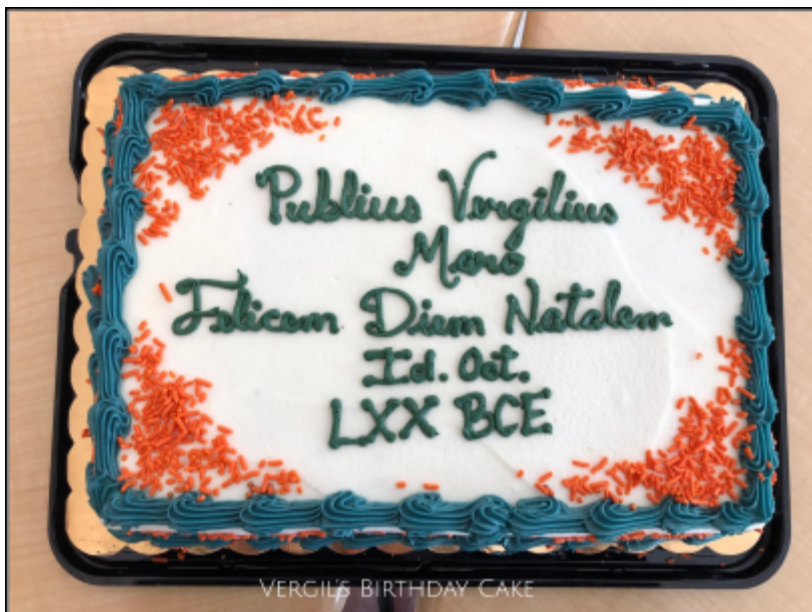

A NEW DISCOVERY IN POMPEII

A ROMAN FRESCO HAS RECENTLY BEEN EXCAVATED IN POMPEII. IT FEATURES TWO GLADIATORS IN BATTLE. THE ONE ON THE LEFT HOLDS A SHORT SWORD AND HAS HIS SHIELD RAISED. THE GLADIATOR ON THE LEFT IS IN A COWERING POSITION. HE HAS DROPPED HIS SWORD AND HIS SHIELD. HIS RIGHT ARM MAY BE HIDDEN BEHIND HIS BACK OR COMPLETELY CHOPPED OFF. THE DEGREE OF THIS INJURY IS UP TO THE JUDGMENT OF THE VIEWER. IN THE FRESCO, THE SEVERE INJURIES OF THE LOSING GLADIATOR ARE DEPICTED WITH A LOT OF BLOOD, EVEN DRIPPING DOWN FROM HIS BODY AND ONTO THE GROUND.

ARCHAEOLOGISTS BELIEVE THAT THIS FRESCO WAS DISCOVERED IN WHAT WAS ONCE A BASEMENT. THEY BELIEVE THE BASEMENT WAS ONCE A SHOP. ABOVE THIS BASEMENT IS THOUGHT TO BE A TAVERN AND BROTHEL DUE TO THE FRESCO BEING OF GLADIATORS, IT IS EXPECTED THAT THIS PLACE WAS A FAVORITE SPOT OF GLADIATORS.

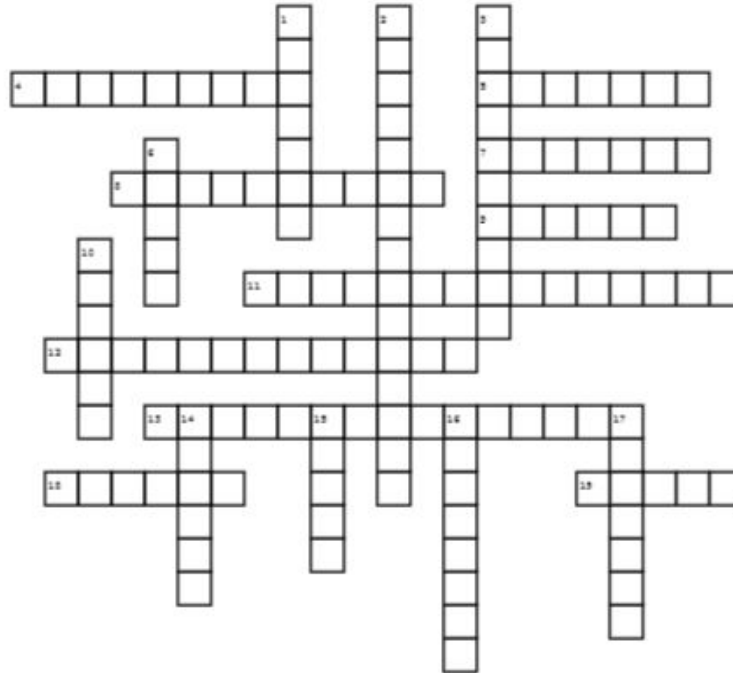
ITALY'S CULTURE MINISTER, DARIO FRANCESCHINI, SAYS "THE DISCOVERY OF THIS FRESCO SHOWS THAT POMPEII IS AN INEXHAUSTIBLE MINE FOR RESEARCH AND KNOWLEDGE FOR ARCHAEOLOGISTS." POMPEII'S DIRECTOR GENERAL MASSIMO OSANNA TOOK NOTE OF THE REALISTIC DEPICTION OF THE GLADIATOR'S WOUNDS.

THIS DISCOVERY IS NOT THE END OF THE WORK TO BE DONE WITH THIS FRESCO. SPECIALISTS WILL NEED TO EXAMINE IT TO HELP ASSESS ITS AGE. POMPEII, ON THE OUTSKIRTS OF NAPLES, WAS OCCUPIED BY THE ROMANS AND THEN DESTROYED BY THE EARTHQUAKE AND VOLCANIC ERUPTION OF MOUNT VESUVIUS IN 79 AD. THE VOLCANO'S ERUPTION WAS ABLE TO PRESERVE MUCH OF POMPEII. DUE TO ITS PRESERVATION, POMPEII HAS OFFERED INSIGHTS INTO ROMAN HISTORY FOR MANY YEARS. SOME PEOPLE MAY ASK, "IF POMPEII HAS ALREADY BEEN EXCAVATED, HOW HAVE THEY MADE A NEW DISCOVERY?" DUE TO A LACK OF FUNDING, THERE IS MUCH OF POMPEII STILL TO BE DISCOVERED. WITH EVERY NEW EXCAVATION, WE LEARN MORE ABOUT THE PAST AND THE SIMILARITIES AND DIFFERENCES BETWEEN OURSELVES AND THE ANCIENT ROMANS.

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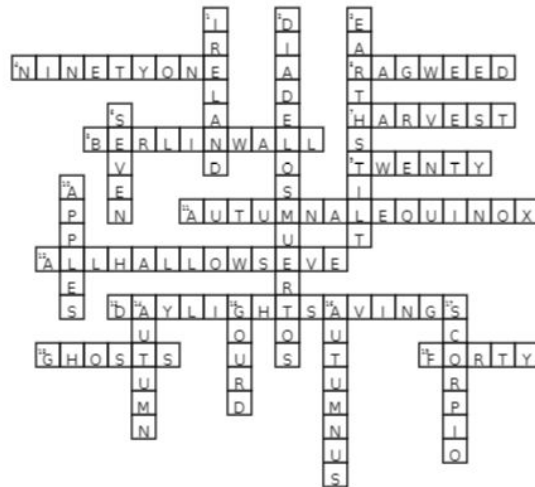
